This non-profit event is organized and run by the Trenton Rotary Club. The Roar on the River maintains its longevity and enthusiastic following because of its unprecedented



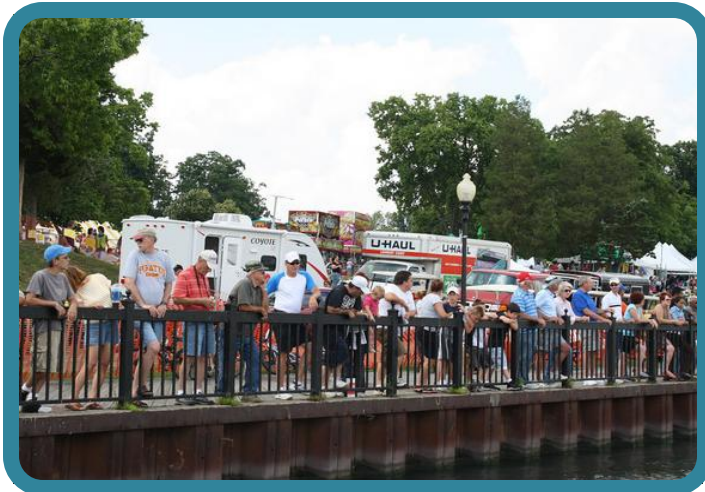
support from the business community. Last year alone, more than 125 businesses and organizations were part of the
